PLEASE NOTE: these regulations are being provided so that all potential arts and crafts exhibitors are aware of the regulations prior to completing an application for the show. **Completed application, prior year participation or membership status does not guarantee current year's event acceptance.** Applications will be reviewed and if accepted, confirmation letters will be mailed. Fees will only be accepted from confirmed exhibitors.

Arts / Crafts Exhibitor Regulations and Application

- Art in the Park is an event of the Thomasville Rose Show & Festival held outdoors annually in historic Paradise Park. The number of visitors specific to Art in the Park vary greatly each year and are dependant upon weather, currant economic climate, etc. Our organizers "guess-timate" an average of 2,500 visitors on a fair weather day.
- Art in the Park is open to Artisans selling their own handcrafted and original work.
- Art and Craft exhibitors will be carefully selected based on creativity, appropriateness and originality.
- This is not a buy-sell show. Items that resemble manufactured or commercially packaged products will not be permitted (this includes, but is not limited to, mass produced ceramics, bedspreads, comforters, etc.).
- Show Fee is \$75 (payable upon acceptance).
- Application deadline: ~~February 1, 2010~~. Exhibitors will be notified by mail of acceptance or denial to show by February 26, 2010. **Application Deadline Extended to February 12, 2010!**
- Completed application must include 1 current photo of exhibitor's booth and no less than 5 photos of the items requested to be sold during the show. ALL exhibitors must submit photos, even if they have submitted and been accepted in the past.
- Each booth space is 20' wide by 20' deep. All booths are outdoors.
- The Art in the Park Committee reserves the right to limit the number of applicants with similar art mediums (i.e.: "x" number of jewelers, "x" number of potters, and so forth). This works to everyone's advantage.
- All items requested to be sold during the show must be listed on the application. (i.e.: Art Medium – photographer; Items – original photos, framed and unframed) A detailed inventory-type listing is not necessary.
- Exhibitors must supply their own tents, display tables, panels or pedestals as needed. (*Tents with weight provisions are strongly encouraged, as this is an outdoor event. Exhibitor area is somewhat shaded; however, a shady booth space cannot be guaranteed*).

- All tables (both display and supply) are required to be covered with floor length coverings to hide unsightly table legs, supplies, boxes, etc.
- Exhibitors are responsible for collecting and paying Georgia sales tax.
- Exhibitor cancellation of a confirmed booth may be made, and a full refund given, if done by March 31, 2010. After this date, refunds will not be given.
- All vendors must have booths set up and vehicles removed from the Park by 9 a.m., Saturday, April 24th.
- Parking will not be permitted at booths during the operating hours of the show. A designated Exhibitor parking area will be created and a limited number of parking passes will be issued to each accepted exhibitor. Please note: Volunteers will be on site to assist with restocking needs with non-invasive transportation.
- Booth set up: Pre-show set-up is scheduled for 4-7 p.m., Friday, April 23rd and is strictly enforced. Plan accordingly; booth set-up will not be permitted outside this time frame on Friday due to traffic flow (the Rose Parade is held Friday evening and various detours will be in place). Booth set-up will resume Saturday, April 24th at 7a.m. Show opens to the public at 10 a.m. Saturday, April 24th.
- The Art in the Park Committee reserves the right to change booth assignments. Exhibitors who have set up in an area not assigned to them and without prior approval by on-site staff, will be required to move to their assigned space.
- If you are an exhibitor who has participated in prior years, please understand that "same booth space" requests will not be honored.
- Exhibitors may not break down their booths until 4pm Saturday, April 24th.
- Electricity is limited and will be available for uses directly related to the demonstration of art or craft: i.e.: to run blow-dryers for quick dry of paint, to operate pottery wheel, to operate wood lathes, etc. An electrical needs request form must be returned with application for consideration. Generators will not be permitted at the event. Please plan accordingly.
- Any exhibitor not abiding by the regulations set forth by the Art in the Park Committee of the Thomasville Rose Show and Festival, will forfeit their privilege to participate in the current and future shows.
